# Building Partnerships:

Key Stakeholder Engagement

Timely Communication during non-emergencies

Face to Face Interactions

Follow up on concerns and issues

Strategic Action during a real event – (IMT)



# Coordinated Assessments:

Involve locals in Big Picture Plans

Maps and Emergency Action Plans at Projects

Historical data collection at the local level

Asset and Resource lists

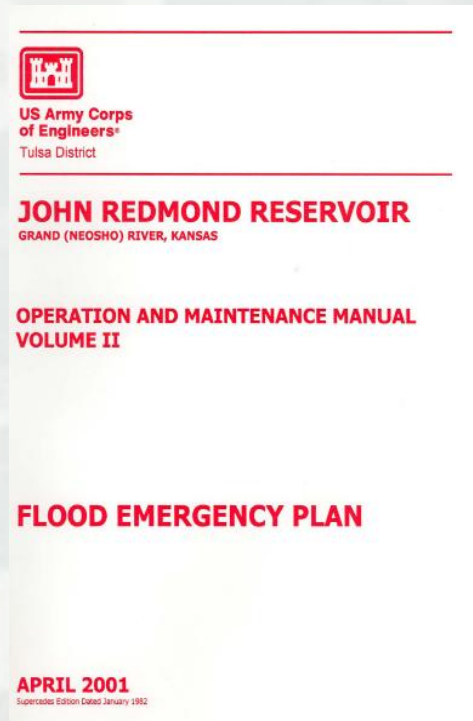

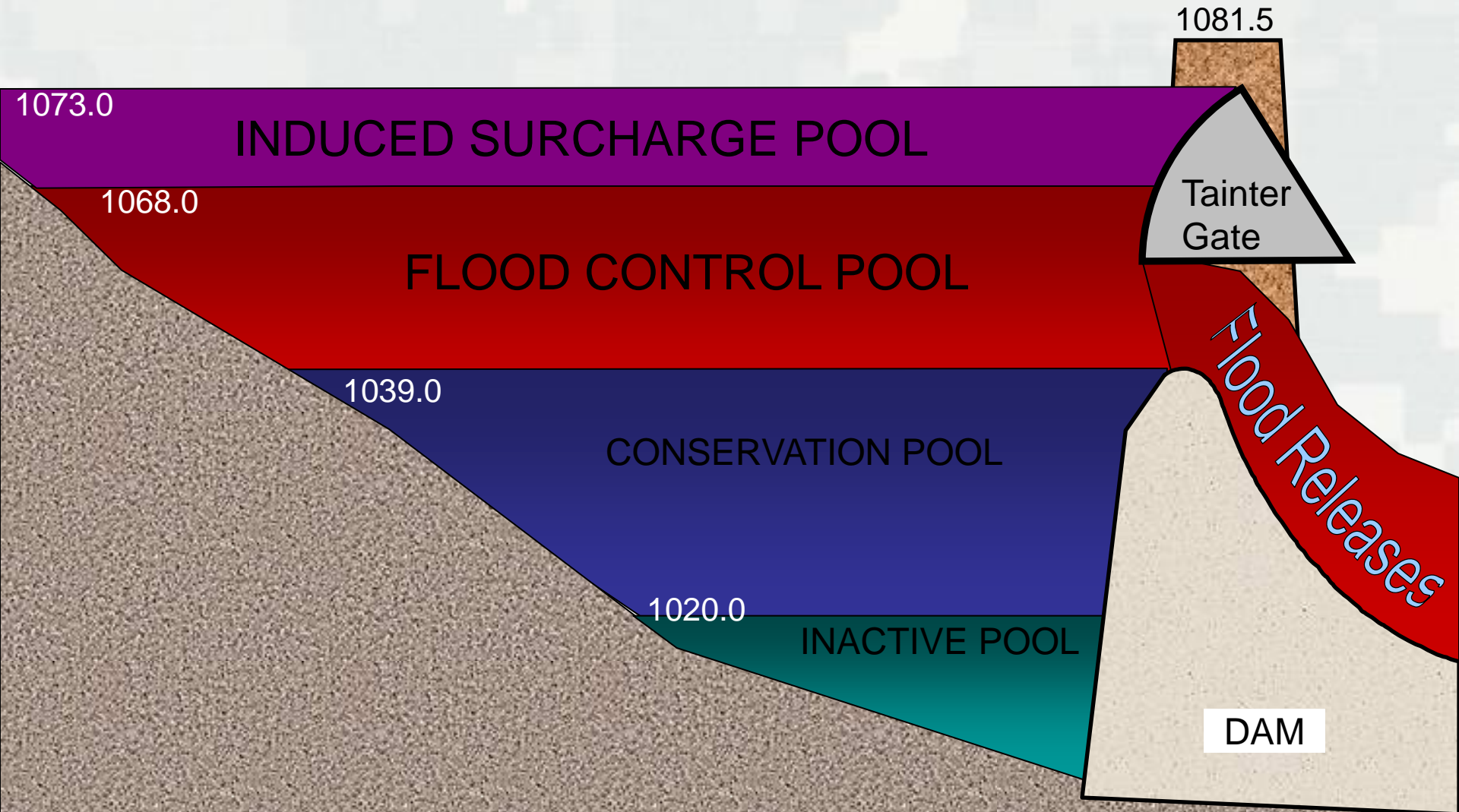


# How to Begin

- Build your Team
- Start with communities where flooding has occurred or is at higher risk for flooding
- Typical Event Schedule includes:
  - ▶ Introductions and Welcome
  - ▶ Review of FPM Assessments
  - ▶ Historical Flooding Review
  - ▶ Levee and Dam Status
  - ▶ Review of Existing Inundation Maps
  - ▶ Emergency Action Plan Review
  - ▶ Scenario Based Flood Event
  - ▶ PL84-99 Review
  - ▶ Flood Control and Coastal Emergencies Program
