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# *FY11 Pilot Project Overview*



- “Proof” of Interagency Approach
- Selection Criteria focus on
  - integrated flood risk management solutions
  - communication of results
- Selections will cover broad range of FRM issues
  - Coastal
  - Levee Safety
  - Various phases of life-cycle
- May utilize tools: SVP, SimSuite, WIDT
- Proposals due 30 August
  - Later proposals will be considered for FY12, if \$ avail



# Selection Criteria



1. Demonstrates flood risk reduction. This does not have to be measured in dollars, but should be able to be communicated clearly.
2. Leverages resources invested by others. Does the work fill a gap, support an interagency solution? Resources can be data/information, talent/labor, or funding. An example of leveraging labor only would be implementation of a building code.
3. Reduces future obligation. For example, reduces future consequences and reduces the expected payout from NFIP or reduces future emergency response and recovery needs.
4. Includes an action, as part of an existing strategic master plan, or as a result of developing a strategic master plan through the Pilot.
5. Does not transfer the risk to another party or a future generation.
6. May be any phase of the flood risk life-cycle.
7. May utilize SVP, WIDT, and/or SimSuite.
8. May include solution to an issue in the State Hazard Mitigation Plan, or similar comprehensive plan.
9. May include enhancing or developing processes; for example, formal integration of the Silver Jackets team into the state's flood risk management approach.





# *FY11 Pilot Project Next Steps*
